- continued staff capability development and targeted professional learning
- increasing student access to the Speech Language Therapist


Creating a visible culture of data literacy to focus student improvement in communication, literacy, numeracy and positive behaviour through:

- implementation of targeted school improvement teams that operate within the systems and processes of Stebbins' HPT school to effect positive change to student learning outcomes

Targeted professional learning improving collective staff efficacy to enact a school wide Zones of Regulation program to improve student self-regulation

Our school will improve student outcomes by

• Increasing Speech Language Therapy support	\$22,500
• Increasing Guidance Officer support	\$8,000
• Additional Administration Support	\$11,000
• Providing coaching model teacher release time	\$20 000
• Building staff capability by using the pedagogy of High Performing Teams	\$16 000
• Supporting the school swimming program	\$10 000
• Providing additional Communication, Literacy and numeracy resources and supports	\$7000
• Providing additional teacher release time for sector curriculum planning and data conversations	\$10 000
• Providing release time for staff release time capability development	\$36 000
• Increasing the skills and capability of school leaders	\$14 000
